The Town of Van Buren Public Works Department is currently accepting applications for a Truck Driver. This is a regular part-time position with winter on-call hours. This is semi-skilled manual labor in the operation of light and moderately heavy trucks and motorized equipment on road construction and repair, and in the snow and ice removal operations of the Public Works Department. The selected applicant must be able to handle and operate all truck attachments and carry out assignments with relative ease. Employee may operate larger pieces of equipment, but only on a temporary or emergency basis. The ability to perform manual labor including but not limited to rebuilding storm drains and culverts, patching and building roads, general repair and preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment and assists in general maintenance of the garage. Perform other duties within Public Works as needed under the direction of the Department Head. Applicant must have high school diploma and a combination of experience and training in the operation of standard automotive equipment heavier than a passenger vehicle. You are required to have a valid Class II Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and be insurable under the Town's vehicle insurance coverage.
